





- Calls for service +7.5%


Longview Group A *Persons* Crime Rate per 1000 population

NIBRS Group A persons offenses includes Simple & Aggravated Assault, Homicide, Robbery, Sex Offenses, Intimidation, Kidnapping


Longview Select "Group A" Count of Persons Crimes


Longview Other Group A Offenses Count








LPD Calls for Service 5 Yr Trend




Calls for service are up 28% from 2009 to 2013



Ticket Counts by Month & Store Type





Image Counts by Month & Store Type
